Crater Lake National Park is organizing a Volunteer Nordic Ski Patrol. The primary purpose of the patrol is to insure that park ski trails are properly marked and signed. Crater Lake's heavy snowfalls require the frequent raising and lowering of directional signs to insure their visibility. On occasion, volunteers may be asked to participate in searches for lost skiers and provide first aid. Persons applying should be intermediate or better cross country skiers, in good physical condition, and have a desire to help the park with its winter program. 
